Advocate for Rural Health



Rural Health

- Approximately 60 million, or 1 in 5, Americans reside in rural areas.
- Rural health care suffers from long-standing challenges, including: healthcare workforce shortages; lower health insurance coverage; vulnerable healthcare facilities; distance and inadequate transportation; limited broadband access; and higher prevalence of chronic disease.

Infrastructure

- Rural hospitals << like mine/in my state>> play a critical role in providing local health care and continue to be on the front lines in our rural communities.
- Since 2010, nearly 170 rural hospitals have closed, or ended inpatient services, leaving many residents
 having to travel double the distance to obtain basic health care needs. When a rural hospital closes, not
 only does the community lose access to vital health care, but a major employer and community
 lynchpin exits, affecting the larger community.
- It is critical Congress uses every tool to equip rural providers with the stability they need to keep their doors open. Currently, **more than 50% of rural hospitals** operating on on negative margins.
- Legislative asks: Rural Hospital Legislative Priorities-Infrastructure; Rural Hospital Legislative Priorities,

Workforce

- Workforce shortages are plaguing rural providers<<in my state/like mine>>. There are currently 5,467
 Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs) in the US, with over 60% of them being located in rural
 areas.
- 65% of rural areas do not have a psychiatrist for behavioral health issues and also **lack many other** specialists.
- Only 10% of US physicians practice in rural areas, despite rural representing nearly 20% of the US population.
- Current healthcare workforce shortages greatly impact my <<facility, community, etc.>> ability to provide
 care
- Legislative asks to reference: Rural Hospital Legislative Priorities-Workforce

Equity:

- In comparison to our urban, rural areas are more likely to be affected by social determinants of health and inequities that prevents proper healthcare access and health outcomes.
- Rural communities have more **uninsured residents**, as well as higher rates of unemployment, leading to less access to care.
- Lack of high-speed internet access can be a hindrance to accessing information, representing another challenge rural Americans face.
- Legislative asks to reference: <u>Rural Hospital Legislative Priorities</u>-Equity
